## **NEW BUSINESS**

Swimming Pool Policy Changes

Mr. Edwards reported that due to recent incidents at the Womelsdorf Pool, Council is enacting the following policy changes for the safety and protection of our members, guests and staff.

- Day passes will only be issued to: a) Guests of Womelsdorf Pool Members;
   b) Womelsdorf Borough Residents; and c) Guests of Womelsdorf Borough Residents. All Guests must be accompanied to the pool by their sponsor. Sponsors are limited to four (4) guests a day unless prior approval for more guests is obtained from Womelsdorf Borough.
- 2. Proof of Womelsdorf Borough Residency will be required if you are requesting a day pass without a Pool Member as your sponsor.
- 3. All Pool Members or Residents sponsoring Guests, will be held responsible for their guests' behavior as well as their own. Memberships and access to the pool may be suspended or revoked for actions of guests as well as action of Members/Residents.
- 4. Proof of Residency can be, but is not limited to: -driver's license or non-drivers State ID
  -a current copy of a utility bill with your Borough address on it.

After discussion on the swimming pool policy changes; <u>Motion</u> by Mr. Mellon, second by Mr. Fidler. Motion carried unanimously.

With no further business brought before Council, <u>Motion</u> by Mr. Fidler, second by Mr. Miller to adjourn the meeting. This meeting adjourned at 3:55pm.
